I enclose now in this letter.

Some material which will give you an insight of the present day situation of the Artists in Holland. I hope you will find it informative and the right thing, wanted by the members of the A. S. A.

In the newsletter of July, I read you need translations of articles in German. If you cannot find any today, would that, I may try to have it translated here, because in Holland many people speaks German and English.

Friends of mine have seen the exhibition of unpublished illustrations and told me, they found it very interesting. They told me too, my works were placed there very good. I am sorry I could not see it myself. Should it be possible for the A-S.A. to send me a catalogue of this exhibition? I should like very much to have one?

Then I should like to ask you another thing: should it be possible for me, to find a studio in London for a few



weeks? Do you know any painter who would like to change studio with me for a while? Maybe some one should be interested in working in Holland for a short period? This exchange of studio would be for the time of four to six weeks.

For some painters such an exchange might be interesting? I found London so exciting, that I shall do all possible to come back and to work there.
